

### 2014 in pictures



















In **2014**, the AREVA Corporate Foundation lent its support to **44 projects** and monitored their implementation. These actions benefitted disadvantaged peoples, **especially children**, in three areas: **access to healthcare**, **education and culture**.

The Foundation spends **two thirds of its annual budget in France**, with the rest going to countries in which the group is based, particularly **South Africa, India, Mongolia and Niger**.

The group's **employees** participate actively each year in programs designed specifically for them: **calls for projects**, volunteer **missions** to India and Africa, and the **solidarity sports challenge** in which **thousands of employees** took part at the group's sites.


