
Apply for Orano Canada's Mill Operator Training Program

Program Overview:

Students will develop the knowledge and skills required to work in a uranium mill operation. This training includes:

- Mill Unit Processes
- Power Mobile Equipment (PME)
- Lockout/Tagout
- Confined Space Entry
- Personal Fall Protection
- Radiation Protection
- Transportation of Dangerous Goods
- **WHMIS**

The program will have ten positions available, with a minimum of five positions reserved for Athabasca Basin residents and minimum of three position for female candidates. Orano reserves the right to change the number of positions available without notice.

Orano Canada Inc. is offering a Mill Operator Training Program at the McClean Lake Operation in the winter of 2025 (exact dates to be determined).

The training rotation is two weeks at site and two weeks at home, for a total of six weeks on site training. Wage subsidy will be provided. Travel and start dates to be determined.

Employment Opportunities:

Individuals who successfully complete the entire program and meet required employment criteria will be eligible for employment with Orano at the McClean Lake Operation.

Applicant Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Have completed a minimum of Grade 12
- Be a resident of Saskatchewan's North and/or a resident of the Athabasca Basin communities
- Complete a criminal record check

Applications must include:

- Cover letter and resume with three references
- High school or GED XII transcript
- Proof of residency in an NSAD or Athabasca Basin Community (driver's license, utility bill, etc.)
