

Orano's Investment in Saskatchewan

McClellan Lake Operation, located in Treaty 10, the Traditional Territory of the Denesūliné and Cree peoples, and Homeland of the Métis.

Orano Canada (Orano) is a leading producer of uranium in Canada and has been exploring for uranium, developing mines and producing uranium concentrate for more than 60 years. The Orano-operated McClellan Lake Mill (joint venture with Denison Mines) is a unique facility that allows for the processing of high-grade uranium ore without dilution and has been safely operating in northeast Saskatchewan since 1999.



Regulatory Process

The McClellan Lake Operation's Licence to Operate will come up for renewal in 2027. This means Orano will be filing preliminary licence renewal application documents with the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) in May 2025.

- In May 2025, Orano will submit a request to renew its licence for 15 years.
- Orano will engage with interested parties leading up to relicensing in 2027 and beyond.
- A public CNSC hearing will be scheduled in 2027 to consider Orano's request.
- Interested parties may apply for funding from the CNSC to participate in the hearing, and receive funds to be used for review of documentation and hearing travel.

Orano strives to meet expectations of rightsholders and partners and include them in our activities with a focus on open communication. This collaboration includes engagement, economic benefits, training, employment, and business opportunities in northern Saskatchewan, where Orano is active.
