Mongolia: Orano supports young people's access to university studies



To train future specialists in the region, support education and access to university studies for students, Badrakh Energy*, a subsidiary of Orano Mining in Mongolia, has launched a scholarship program since 2010.

This scholarship program covers the total duration of Bachelor's studies (bachelor's level), i.e. 3 years.

Since its establishment, 51 students from Ulaanbadrakh and Sainshand in Dornogobi province have benefited from these scholarships.

In 2020, 4 scholarship students graduated from prestigious schools: the National School of Physical Education, the University of Science and Technology, the National Teachers' University and the University of Arts and Culture.

Applicants apply to their school and local authorities. Together, the representatives of Badrakh Energy and the local committee select the files according to previously defined criteria.

The selected students are introduced to the members of the Cooperation Council. A final vote validates the award of the scholarship.

* Badrakh Energy: Badrakh Energy, the joint venture between Orano and its partners, Mon Atom and Mitshubishi Corporation, holds 3 mining permits for the Zuuvch Ovoo, Dulaan Uul and Umnut deposits, located in Dornogobi province. Trials at the Zuuvch Ovoo site (extraction + processing) were launched in 2021.
