Mongolia: Livestock reconstitution project



Following a particularly harsh winter of 2007, a livestock reconstruction project was initiated by Orano's subsidiary in Mongolia.

The aim is to support neighbouring farmers in the Zuuvch Ovoo project. Selected by the Local Cooperation Council, the "winning" breeders receive 50 animals (goats and sheeps) for a period of three years. After this period, these breeders have the right to keep the newborns from this herd. Then, they return only the original animals to the project, so that other families can enjoy it.

As natural renewal is not possible due to the distance between the different herds, a livestock exchange program was launched in 2019. A total of 117 families in the Zumbayan region have benefited from this program, allowing their livestock activities to continue.

Since 2022 this program should be extended to the districts around our site and involve more than 30 additional herder families.
